Meeting Notes (Old/New Business, Decisions, Agendas)

One Pill Can Kill is a great resource to learn more about fentanyl. Fentanyl strips are legal in Indiana. Are there other counties using them? What is the accuracy for them?

Not likely that someone using the substances would use the strips to find out if they contain fentanyl. Health Department already has strips. They were given free strips. Chuck will continue to look into this and learn more about it. It's said that Fentanyl is the most profitable drug out there right now.
