Meeting Notes (Old/New Business, Decisions, Agendas)

Intros. New people Kathy Newport and Beverly Maloy. Kathy Newport had done Have a Healthy Baby pre-covid. Bringing Beverly on to help secure the program for next year.

Steve motioned to approve May minutes and John seconded

Steve reported that all claims that had been turned in have been submitted. Passed around spreadsheet for review by group.

The CCP was approved and claims can start being submitted to Nikki and she will send to Steve to turn in to auditor.

4H sign up sheet was passed around again; don't forget you have to have 2 hours of volunteer time by March 30th next year in order to be eligible for funds. We will have the 4H and our Red Ribbon Breakfast this year to get those hours. We also need to figure out if we are doing a booth at HKD or if we want to do something else this year? We also need a plan for 4H Fair which is our BIG event to participate in.

HKD report out. It will be August 6th from 8:30am-12:30pm. We need more sponsors and nonprofits to participate. We want it to be a big nonprofit day. We will allow those nonprofits to participate and if they have fundraisers they can do those that day. For example, the LPD and their pork dinner/lunch to raise money for Shop with a Cop. It will be at Riverside Park. Carousel is being sponsored by Logansport Church/Father's House. It was suggested that the LCC help sponsor the mini golf so that it is free for the community. Rick volunteered to pay for the remainder of the mini golf sponsorship if needed.

Maybe just have a booth with resources not necessarily covering a booth, but helping in other areas. We could acknowledge Partners as sponsoring the mini golf.

What would we like to do at the 4 H fair? Someone suggested the spinning wheel for prizes. We also need to get surveys filled out. Last year was the lowest survey count ever.
